Executive Message:

Thank you for being an advocate for foster and adopted children and their families. It is because of your support, care and concern for children and parents that the Midwest Foster Care and Adoption Association (MFCAA) has been able to provide essential services to families for more than ten years. Together we have changed the lives of thousands of children in a short amount of time.

In this Annual Report you will learn more about our programs, events and services, developed to support families who have lovingly and thoughtfully welcomed foster children into their homes.

Some memorable moments from the past two years include:

- **Celebrating our 10 year anniversary** in 2010 with our annual gala at the 18th & Vine American Jazz Museum.
- **Hosting more than 500 families** in 2009-2010 at The Annual Child Welfare Conference held each October, providing these families with education, resources and networking opportunities.
- **Hosting Nancy Thomas**, nationally known speaker and author of *When Love is Not Enough: A Guide to Parenting Children with Reactive Attachment Disorder* at the 2010 conference. Nancy, the mother of three birth children, two adopted children and one foster child, is recognized internationally as a foremost authority on parenting emotionally disturbed children.
- **Promoting the adoption of 161 children** in 2010 and preventing the adoption disruption of 56 children through respite, advocacy and mentoring services.
- **Supporting more than 50 families** each month through advocacy services.

- **Assisting 220 families** in obtaining education or mental health services for adopted children in 2010.
- **Preventing one or more placement moves** in 25% of foster families.
- **Expanding our food pantry and kids clothing closet** to serve 143 families and 485 children each month in 2010. This number has doubled since 2009 and tripled since 2008.

Our focus is and always will be on children. The knowledge that children in our neighborhoods are being abused and neglected continues to inspire us to find and support families who will without judgment make a place in their hearts and their homes for a child who has experienced physical and emotional trauma. We will always seek to encourage strong, secure and nurturing families for children who need a place to call home.

As we look to the future, we recognize that there is an immediate and rising need for the services of MFCAA. There are currently more than 10,000 children in foster care in the State of Missouri and nearly 8,000 in the State of Kansas. **In Jackson County, Missouri there are 1,500 children in foster care, an increase of 31% from one year ago.** Our 2011 Strategic Plan calls for a new kind of Extreme Recruitment so that we can be on the leading edge of identifying families to become licensed foster care providers to meet the staggering and escalating need.

We are grateful to you, our community partners, for sharing our commitment to **“Transforming the Life of a Child in Crises”**.

Programs and Services:

TRAINING AND SUPPORT

We do not place children in foster homes. MFCAA provides licensing services and actively recruits families to become licensed. We support foster families who occasionally struggle with the financial, emotional and physical stress of parenting children who have been exposed to abuse and neglect. MFCAA provides in-service training and education on topics ranging from parenting a child with emotional issues to simple household repairs. MFCAA also trains social service agency professionals in issues specific to the needs of foster children and families.

Results: *In 2010 MFCAA licensed 41 fostering families. We mentored 44 families, including grandparents raising grandchildren, which is more than a 100% increase in families receiving mentoring, advocacy and respite since 2008. MFCAA assisted 123 families with crisis intervention and provided more needed training for families and social service agency personnel than any other agency in the Kansas City metro.*

RESPIRE

Our respite program is designed to give foster and adoptive parents an occasional break. Because foster and adoptive parents often have 5, 6 or more children in their homes, and at least some of the children are likely to have special medical or behavioral needs, it can be difficult to find and afford appropriate childcare. MFCAA has a list of volunteer respite providers who have gone through appropriate training so that we can match to specific childcare needs. This service is provided at no charge to the foster/adoptive parent.

Results: *In 2009 – 2010 we provided respite services to an average of 20 families each month. By offering this service 100% of the families who receive respite service have retained foster children placed in their homes.*

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

Children arrive at foster homes with nothing but the clothes on their backs. MFCAA provides an emergency clothing closet that allows foster families to meet the immediate needs of children and to supplement the foster care clothing allowance of \$200.00 per year. MFCAA also offers food pantry services two days per week and by appointment to alleviate the additional costs households experience in providing a home to a foster child.

Results: *In 2010 the clothing closet and food pantry assisted an average of 143 families and 485 children per month, nearly doubling the number of families assisted by these services in 2009 and tripling the 2008 number.*

ADVOCACY

Foster and adoptive families deal with complex issues in the legal, educational and health care systems. MFCAA employs qualified advocacy professionals to assist families in navigating these and other systems. We actively follow

legislation on the local, state and national level that impact foster and adoptive families.

Results: *MFCAA provides advocacy services to approximately 50 families every month. In 2010 our advocates assisted 220 families in obtaining educational or mental health services for their foster or adopted children.*

LAWYERS 4 KIDS

This volunteer organization, made up of area legal professionals, provides the resources to fulfill special requests that are made by foster children and their families.

Results: *“Lawyers 4 Kids” has contributed more than \$30,000 in 2009 – 2010 to pay for foster children to participate in such things as sports, camps, music lessons and art classes.*

CHAPTER GROUPS

MFCAA is proud to have several chapters, organized by wonderful, dedicated volunteers in an effort to bring some of MFCAA's programs to Missouri's communities. December, Independence, MO

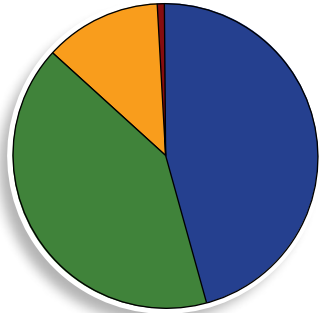

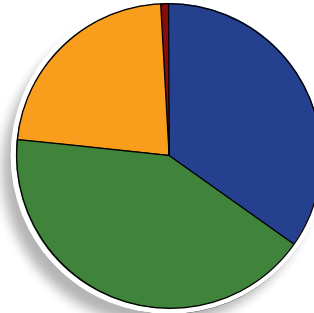

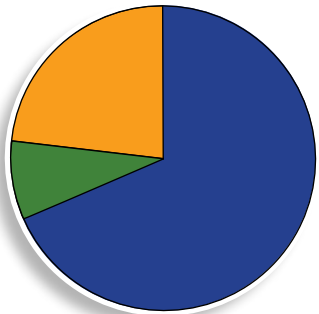

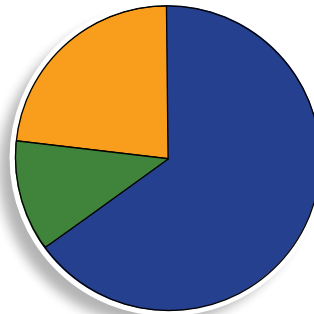
